Habitat: broadleaf and mixed woodland

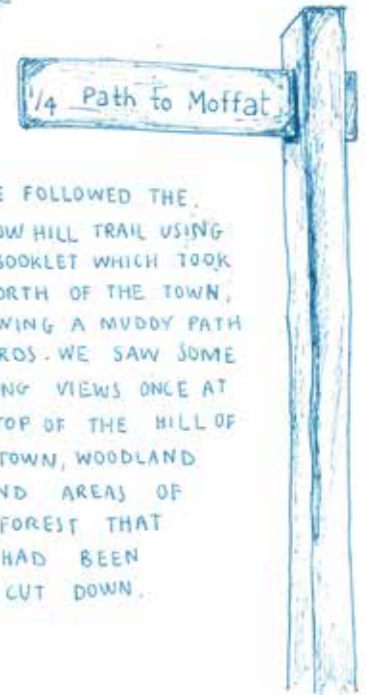
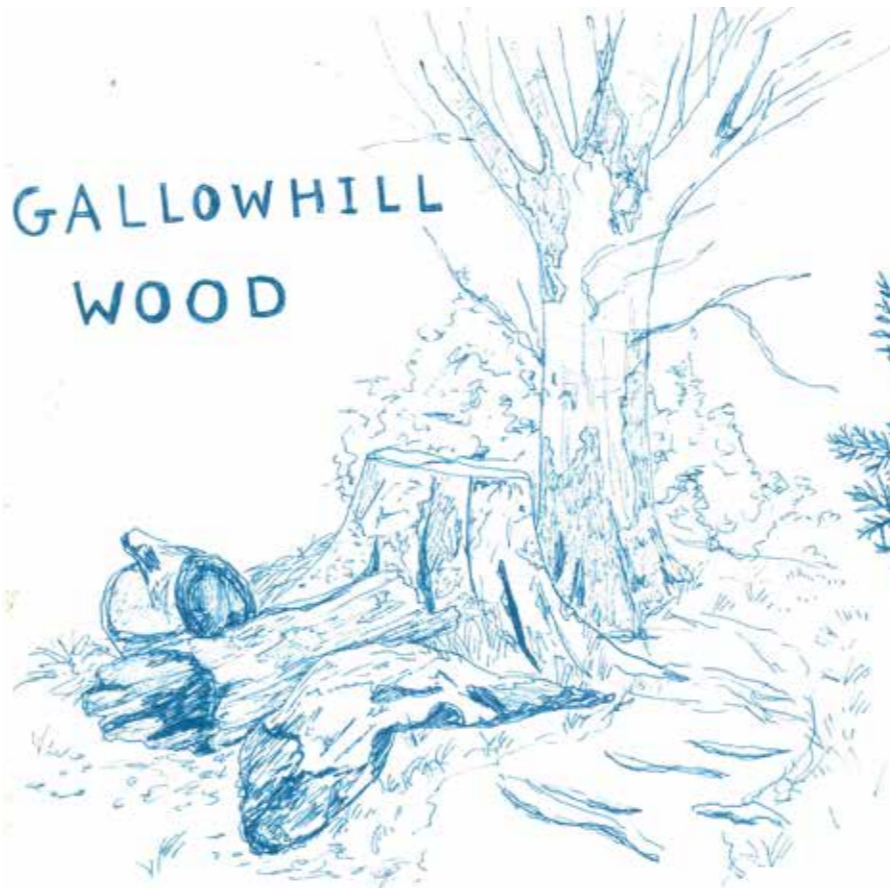
Diet: rabbits, hares, birds and small mammals

It is thought that there are less than 400 wildcats left in the wild

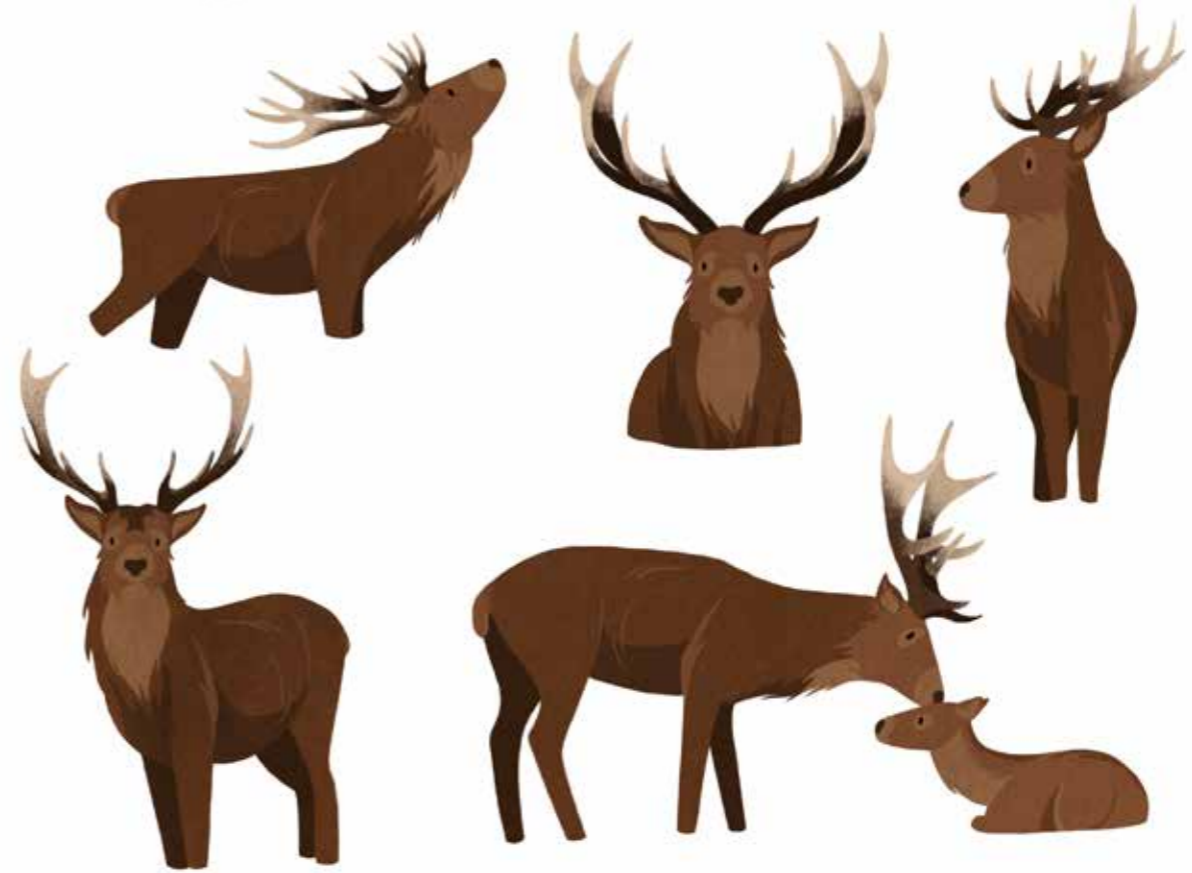
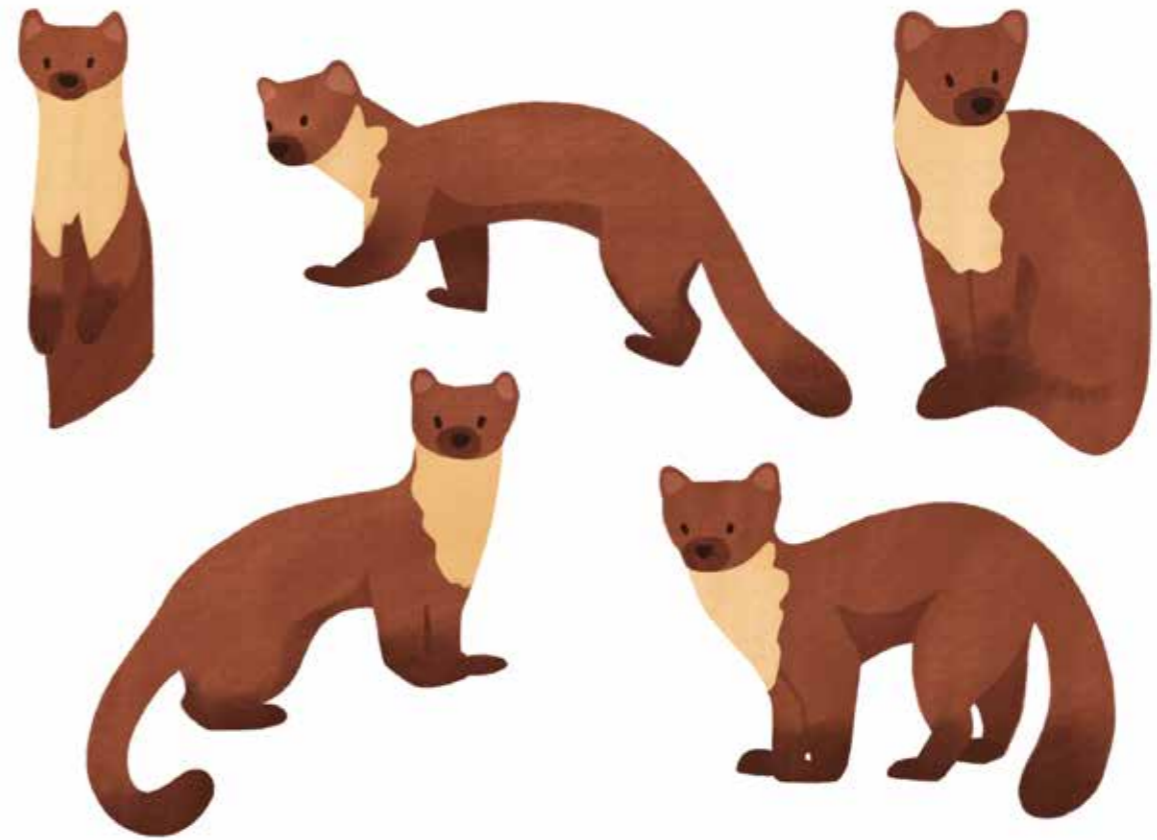
GALLOWHILL WOOD

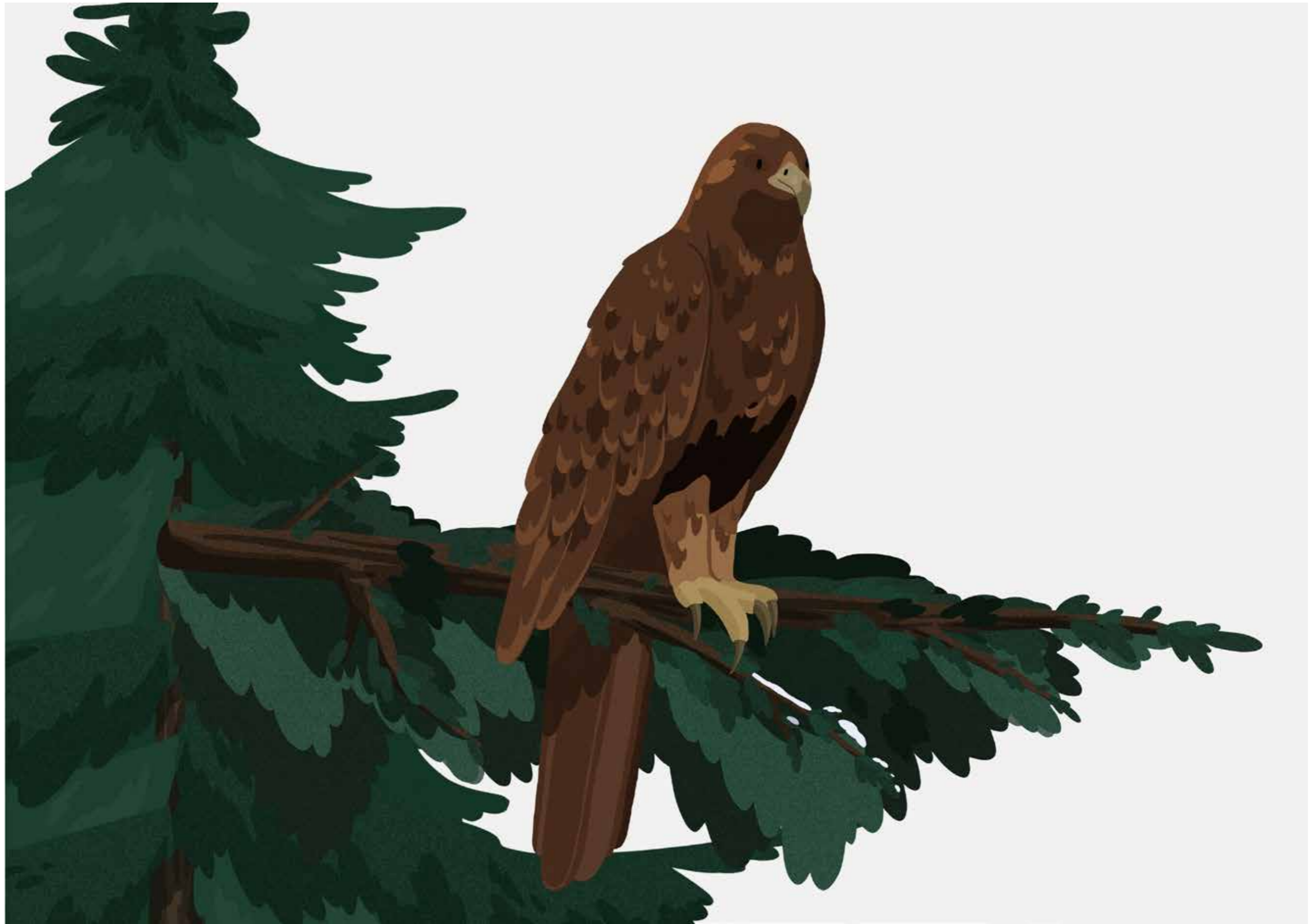

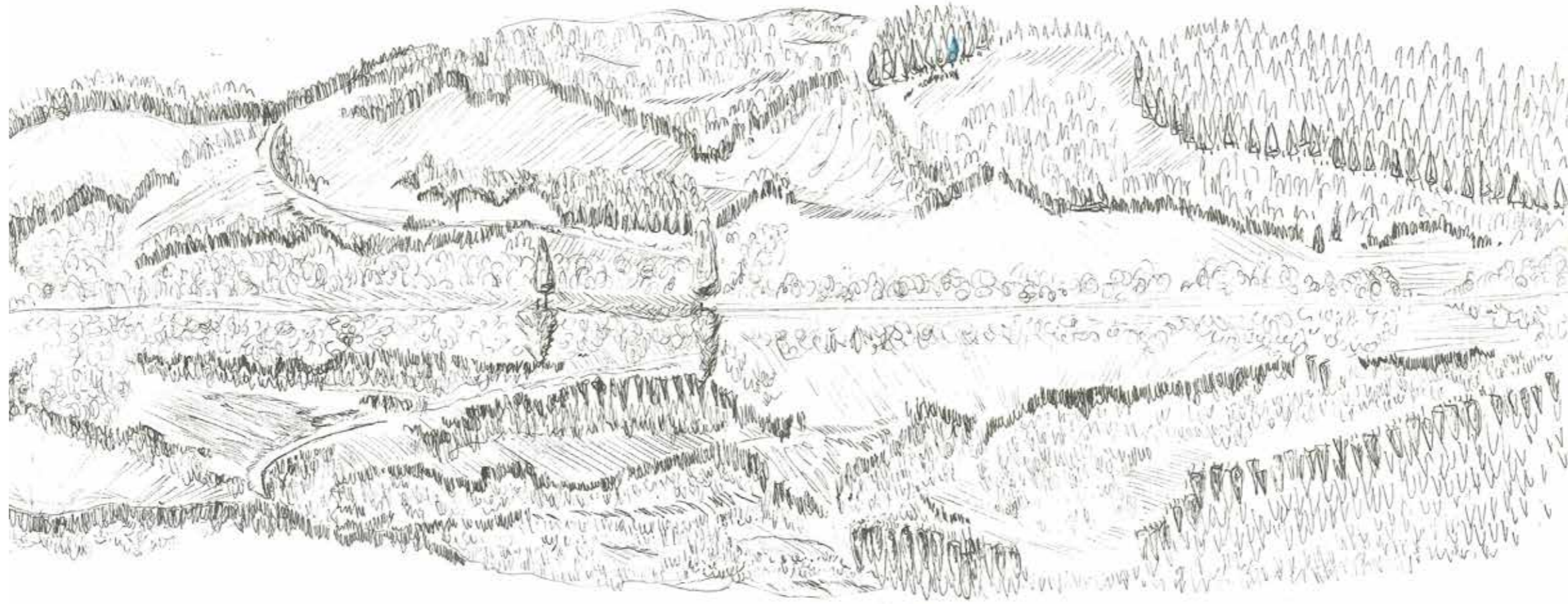

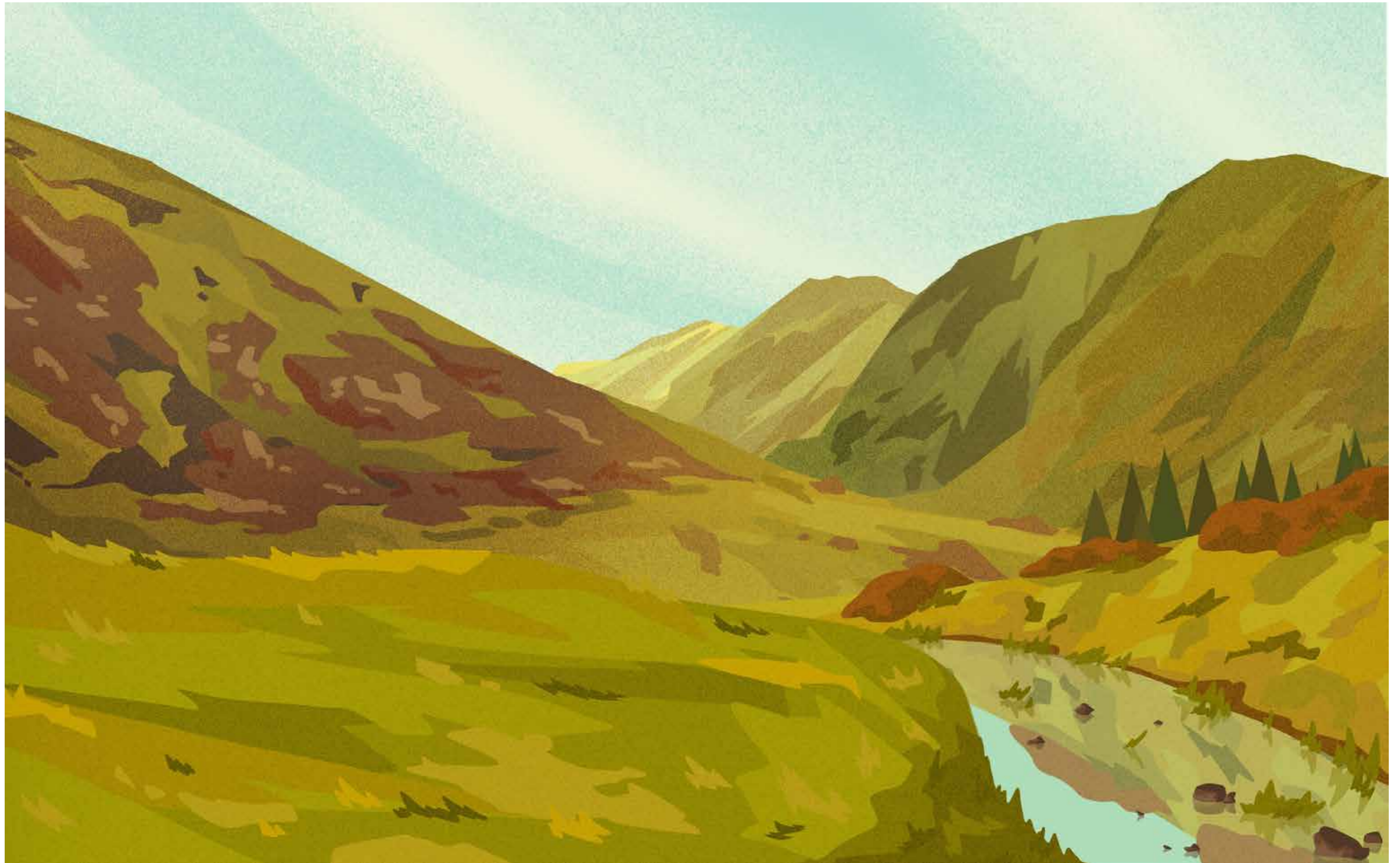

Eurasian Beaver

Castor fiber

The Eurasian Beaver is a keystone species. Through the building of dams, the digging of canals, and the creation of dead wood, beavers create and maintain habitats where an abundance and diversity of life can flourish with studies showing salmon thriving where beavers are present.

Red Deer

Cervus elaphus

Red deer are major shapers of the landscape. They graze grasses and sedges, and browse tree shoots and shrubs such as heather and blaeberry. These mixed feeding actions, combined with trampling and wallowing, have a significant impact on the composition of ground flora and woodland structure.

Golden Eagle

Aquila chrysaetos

The Golden Eagle is an apex predator and plays a vital role at the top of the food chain by controlling the population of small mammals and birds. They help keep a balance and recycle nutrients within the landscape.
